Global Challenge (GC) is a registered charity in the UK with Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) status in Uganda. We support Crossroads Secondary School in Soroti, Uganda by funding:

- Teacher salaries
- School lunches for staff and pupils
- Text books and resources



WHY PROVIDE FUNDING?

In Uganda families have to pay for secondary education regardless of their income, meaning some families cannot afford to send their children to school. At GC we are passionate that education should be accessible for all. So, at Crossroads School pupils pay what their families can afford to. For some this is zero.



SCHOOL HISTORY

GC began supporting Crossroads School in 2007. It was registered as an exam centre in 2014. This has increased the school's reputation in the local area. Although GC provides funding support for Crossroads, the School is run by the teaching staff and Board of Governors in Soroti.
